### **LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION**

We are asking pupils in year 6 and years 7-11 in Derby and Derbyshire to take part in a competition to design a Water Safety Partnership Logo.

The Derbyshire Water Safety Partnership is made up of various stakeholders including the Canal and River Trust, Severn Trent Water, Derbyshire Constabulary and the RNLI. The Partnership aims to maximise water safety, reduce cases of drowning and water related injuries through prevention, education and awareness. We are looking for a logo that embodies this message for us to use.

A winner and two runners up will be chosen by Mr and Mrs Ndlovu; the parents of Thando Ndlovu who sadly passed away in the River Trent in 2021 at the age of 15.

The prizes will include:

A **seasonal parking permit** for use at Carsington, Tittesworth Water, Draycote Water, Linacre Reservoir and Shustoke. A Markeaton Park voucher booklets giving **access to the Mundy Play Centre where equipment includes bouncy castle, mini-golf and canoes (age restrictions may apply)**. A **days free cycle hire** for a family from the visitor's centre at Middleton Top, High Peak Trail and a bug hotel from the environment agency and a **£25 Waterstones gift card**.

The winner will also be **invited to their local fire station** for a tour of the station and meet and greet with the crew.

Please share the above competition information with your year 6-11 pupils, we hope that taking part in this competition over the summer will keep water safety at the forefront of people's minds.

Terms and conditions for Water Safety Partnership logo competition:

1. The closing date for entries is 11:59pm on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and any entries received after this date will not be entered into the competition.
2. Entries are to be sent via email to [competition@derbys-fire.gov.uk](mailto:competition@derbys-fire.gov.uk)
3. The logo designed by the winner of the competition will be incorporated into the Water Safety Partnership's identity. Therefore, entry into this competition implies consent for the entrant's logo design to be used by the Water Safety Partnership.
4. The winning entrant's design will be used publicly by the Water Safety Partnership and its stakeholders, however, the winning entrant's identity will not be shared in relation to the logo design or use without prior written consent from the parent or guardian.
5. Prizes for this competition are as follows for the winner and the two runners up:  
Winner:
  - A seasonal parking permit for use at Carsington, Tittesworth Water, Draycote Water, Linacre Reservoir and Shustoke.
  - A Markeaton Park voucher booklets giving access to the Mundy Play Centre where equipment includes bouncy castle, mini-golf and canoes (age restrictions may apply).
  - A days free cycle hire for a family from the visitor's centre at Middleton Top, High Peak Trail.
  - A bug hotel.
  - £25 Waterstones gift card.
  - An invitation to a local fire station for a tour and meet and greet with the crew.Two runners up:
  - A Markeaton Park voucher booklets giving access to the Mundy Play Centre where equipment includes bouncy castle, mini-golf and canoes (age restrictions may apply).
  - A bug hotel.
6. There is no cash alternative to the prizes for the winner or runners up.
7. Prizes are not transferable to others.
8. This competition is open to children aged 10-16 years (years 6-11) at the time of sending their entry.
9. Entrants must be pupils at a Derbyshire primary and secondary school at the time of entry.
10. Entrants must have permission from a parent or guardian to enter the competition.
11. The winner and two runners up will be judged and chosen by Mr and Mrs Ndlovu, their decision is final. Their decision will be made based on creativity and relevance to water safety.
12. The identity of the applicants and their personal details will not be shared with Mr and Mrs Ndlovu.
13. The personal details of applicants will not be used for any reason other than those stated above which directly relate to this competition.
14. No purchase is necessary for this competition.
15. The winner and two runners up will be announced on the 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023, contact will be made via email directly to the email address used to enter the competition. It is suggested that a parent or guardian emails the entry to DFRS.
16. The parent or guardian of the winner and two runners up will need to contact DFRS via [competition@derbys-fire.gov.uk](mailto:competition@derbys-fire.gov.uk) to claim their prize. They must claim this by 11:59pm on the 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
