It is with great pleasure and immense pride that we can now inform you of the results of our recent Ofsted inspection which took place on the 8th and 9th of November 2023.

The inspectors concluded that Outwood Academy Hasland Hall is **GOOD** in all areas (Quality of Education, Behaviour and Attitudes, Personal Development, Leadership and Management), this results in an Overall Effectiveness of **GOOD** for the school.

The inspectors that visited our academy met with myself (Principal), the Executive Principal, the Vice Principal, students, staff, members of the academy council, other external agencies, spoke with parents, and reviewed documentation provided by the academy. The inspection also included deep dives into multiple subjects, lesson visits and scrutiny of work undertaken by students.
