Ski Trip 2024

Dear Parent/Carer

We are pleased to offer Outwood Academy Hasland Hall students the opportunity to attend a ski trip during February half term in 2024. We will be traveling to La Masella and Molina - Alp 2500, Spain, departing on **Saturday 17 February** and returning on **Friday 23 February**. The resort caters well for school parties offering 'ski to door' and facilities to accommodate all abilities. There is an extensive lift area providing long and scenic runs for beginners, through to challenging runs for more advanced skiers.

Included in the price of £1335 are:

- Return transport by air
- 6 nights full board
- 130 km Lift pass and resort representative
- 5 x 5 hours tuition (3 hours in the morning and 2 hours in the afternoon)
- Hire of ski equipment boots, skis, poles and helmet is included but all other equipment will need to be hired or bought
- Fully comprehensive insurance (including Covid) and snow guarantee.
- Tourist Tax

We anticipate that demand will be extremely high for ski trips and reservations need to be made early. To reserve a place, please return the attached permission slip. Your ParentPay account will then show that a £200 deposit is owed. Once this is paid, this secures your child's place.

This and the other deposits are non-refundable once they have been sent to the travel agent. The second deposit will be required approximately six weeks after the initial payment, followed by another payment of £200 in September. These will again be displayed on ParentPay. The outstanding balance will be required before Christmas, 12 weeks prior to departure. All the booking conditions are available from http://www.321ski.co.uk/downloads/termsandconditions321ski2.pdf Covid assurance - A full refund will be issued if hospitalized within 28 days of departure, test positive before travel or made to self isolate.

The acceptance of reservations is subject to the Principal's and party leaders approval. After this please be aware that reserving a place on the trip does incur a financial responsibility and dropping out at any time will result in loss of deposits and payments made.

There will be an information evening following October half term, where we will share more information on times of departure, hotel, suggested clothing and answer any other questions you may have. This will be attended by the ski provider and also a ski clothing company which will give you an opportunity to buy ski clothing if you wish to do so.
